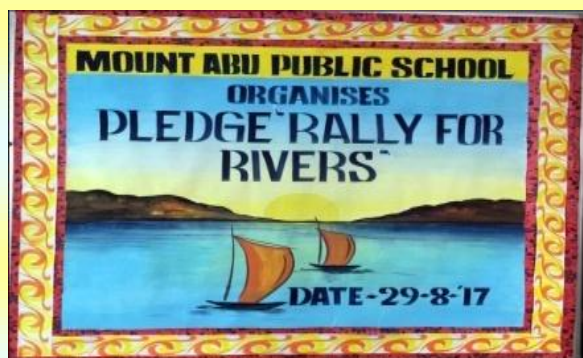
CLASSROOM BULLETIN BOARD DECORATION
