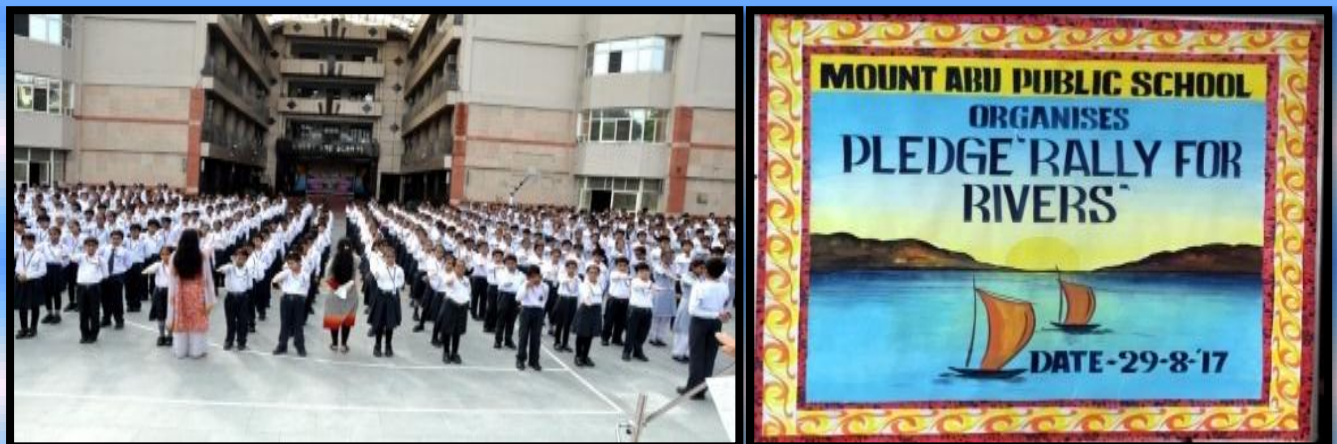
BOOK WEEK ACTIVITY
