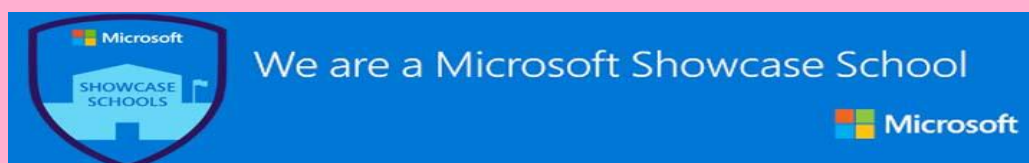


### Outstanding Achievement

E-Waste or Electronic waste is one such waste which is the heated argument based and is mostly a debated topic since time immemorial.

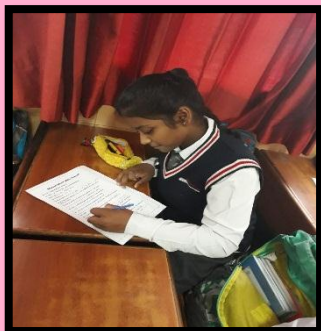
