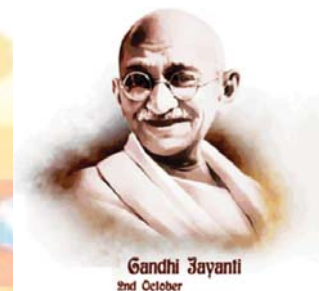
## Bean Sprouts without Soil

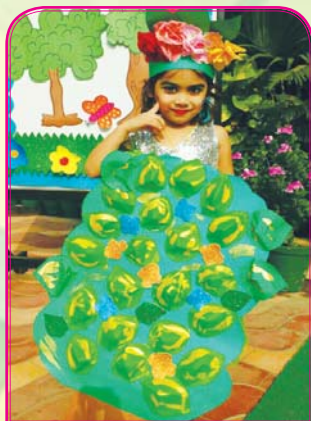
