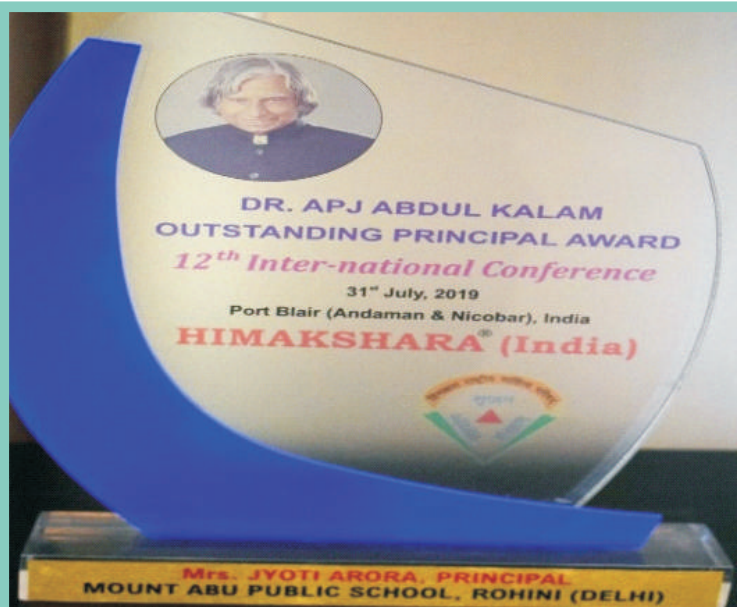
Winner of Hindustan Times Pace - Cheering Team !

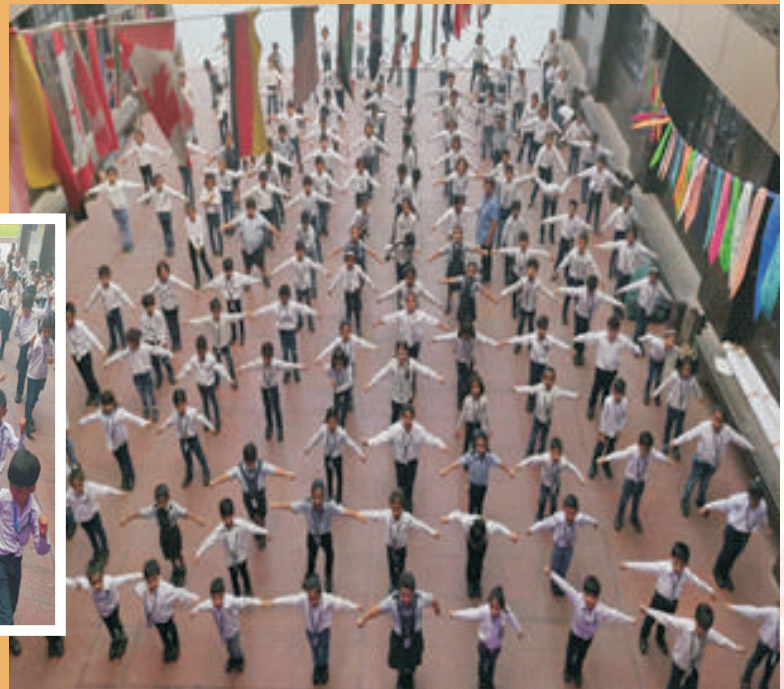
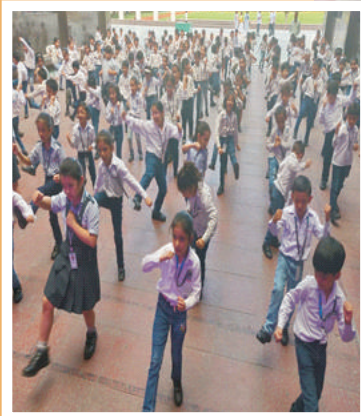
Puppet Show
