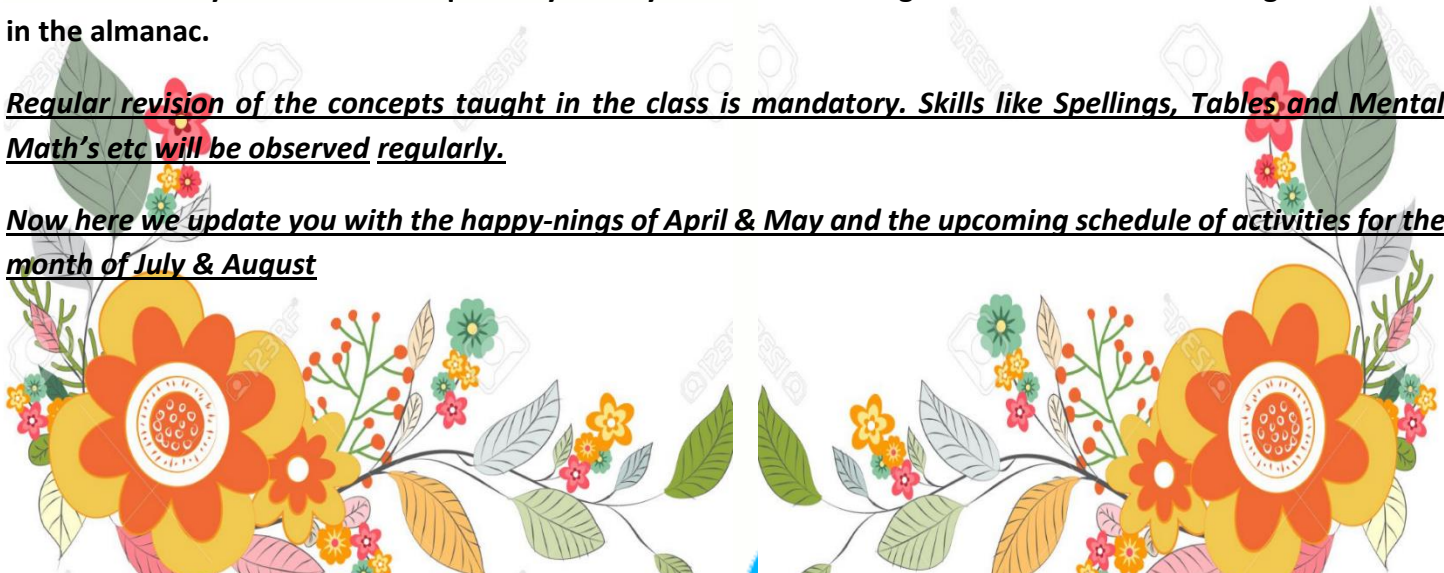
Make your ward aware that each working day in the school is significant for them, therefore you are requested to send your ward regularly to the school and avoid absenteeism on the first and last working day.

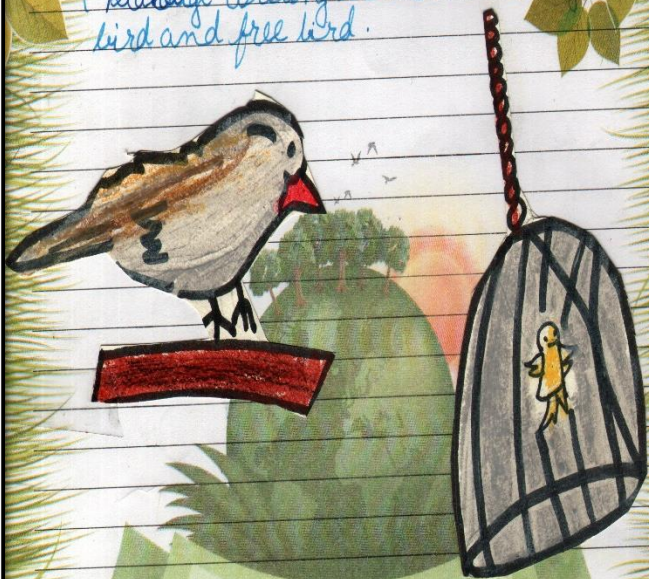

Free bird: How lucky you are, you don't have to roam here and there in search of food or anything else.

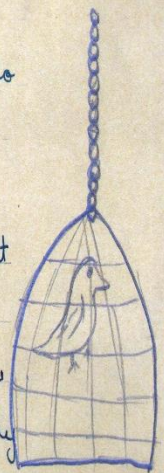
Caged bird: No, it's not like that you are very lucky. You are free to do everything ~~with~~ which you want to do.
