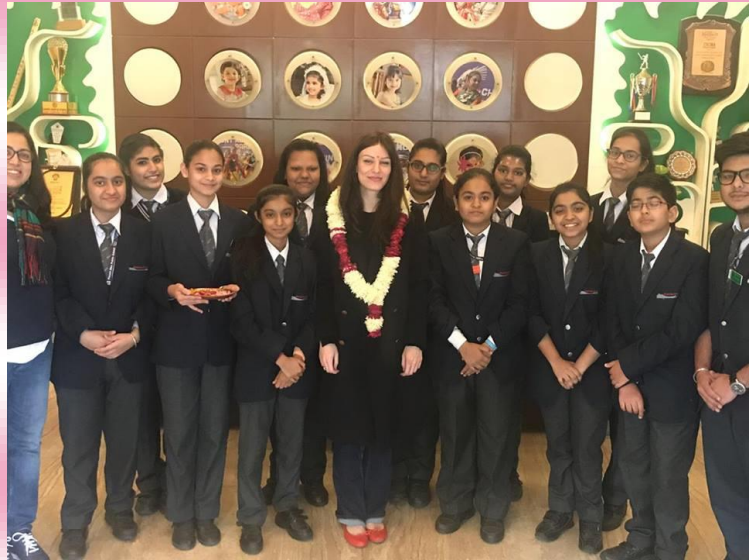

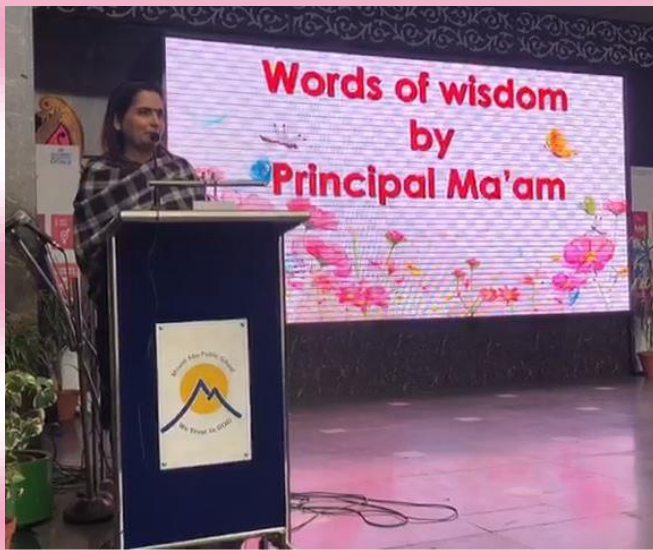
MOCK DRILL ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

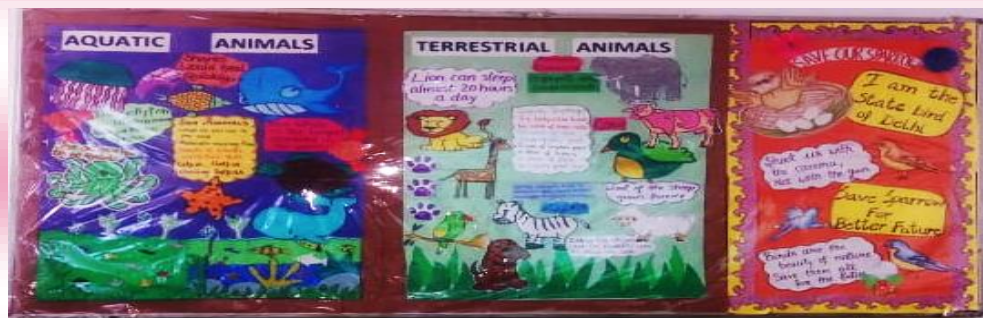
