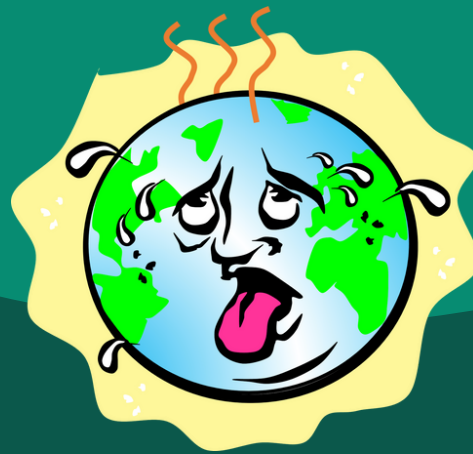


CLEANLINESS DRIVE

GLOBAL CITIZENS VISITED HON'BLE PRESIDENT OF INDIA ON THE OCCASION OF CHILDREN'S DAY

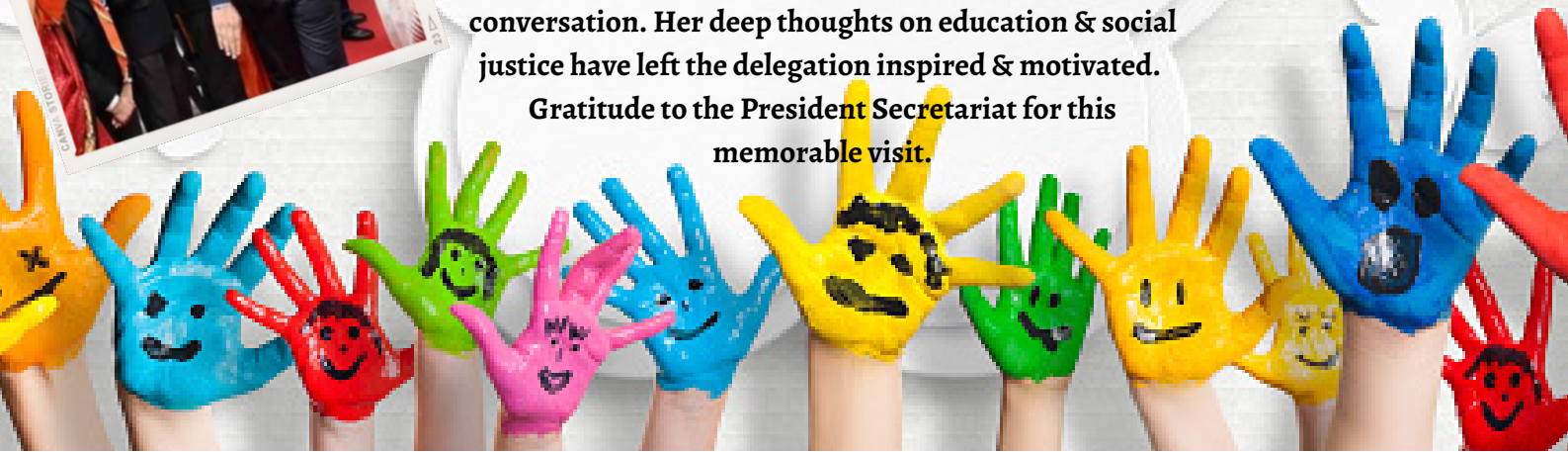


"Inspiring Morning with Hon'ble President of India Draupadi Murmu Ji at Rashtrapati Bhawan.
