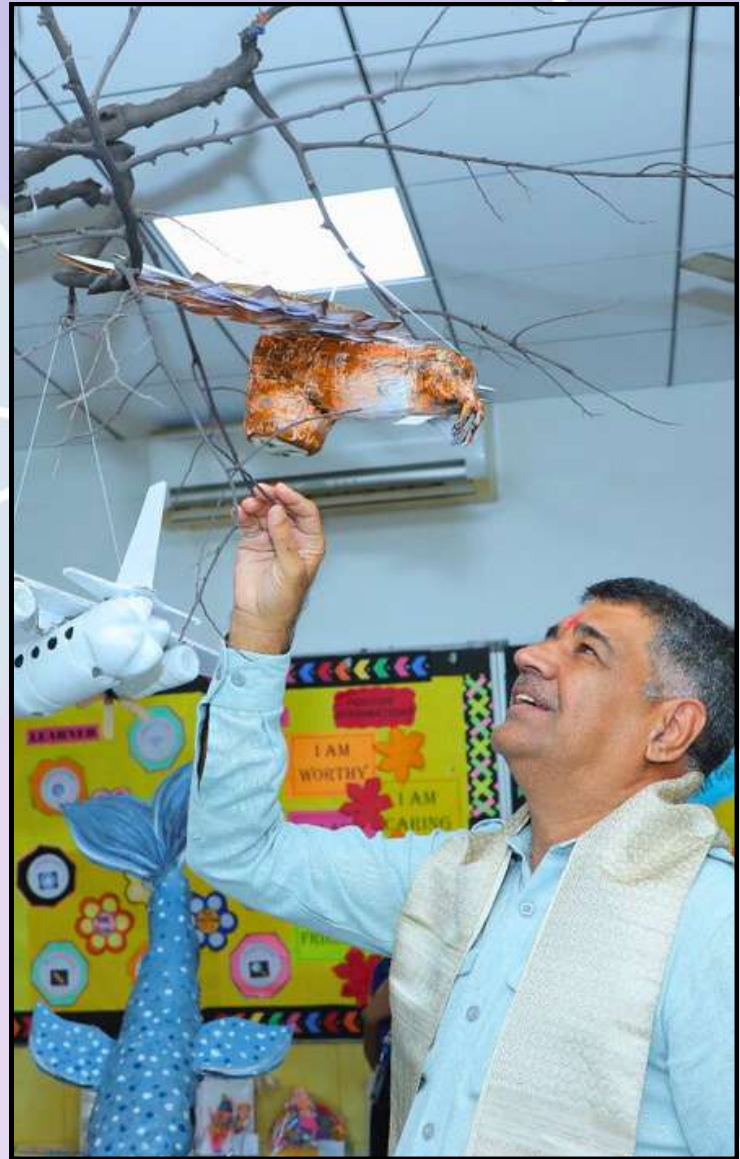
KALAKUNJ INAUGURATED WITH JOYFUL GANESH CHATURTHI CELEBRATION
