






## MOUNT ABU SCHOOL SHINES IN TIMES SCHOOL SURVEY 2025


#### **CELEBRATING A DECADE OF CHANGE**








### **SALUTING A VISIONARY LEADER**






## VIKSIT BHARAT BUILDATHON 2025: YOUTH POWERING INDIA'S VISION
