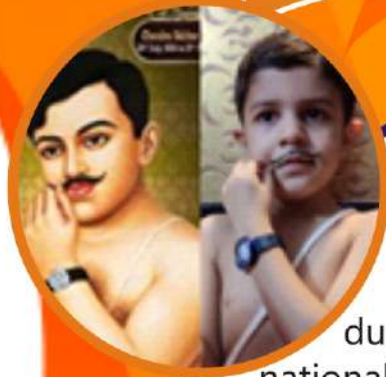
At the end of the day, they expressed their understanding and observation in the reflection sheet.

Principal, Madam Jyoti Arora appreciated the huge participation of kids from all levels and imbibed the rich values of our pride, our country ... Mother India

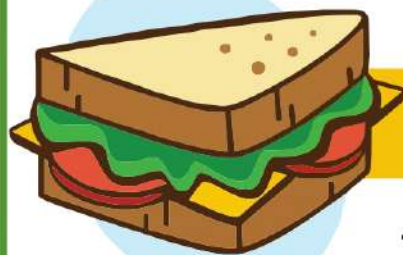
Har Ghar Tiranga

The school witnessed a massive participation for its initiative on 74th Independence Day of India—HAR GHAR TIRANGA.

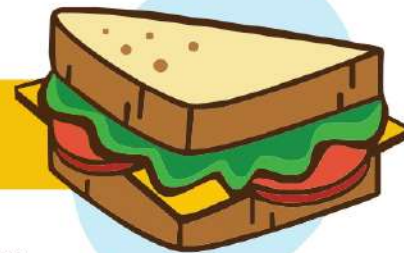
